Dopo la forte burrasca dei 27, 28, 29 dello scorso mese il 1.° del cor-
rente fu magnifico ma tosto si fece rapidum: il barometro ed il 2.° si ebbe
un temporale verso sera alle 7 p. Si rialzò tosto il barom. per tutto rial-
zarsi ^{con tempeste} il 5.° e ripulire il 6 e 7. Il giorno 8 vento N freddissimo
e neve dalla mattina fino alle 2 pom. a riprese - che si ripulge presto.
La notte del 8 cadde pure un po' di neve. Furono due giornate d'inverno
Il minimo fu a 2°. Dal 9 ai 17 il barometro oscillò fra i 763, -
con tempo variabile e lunga pioggia. Al 18 salì con caduta
di nevischio ed abbassamenti forti di temperatura - **Il**

Si ebbero perciò due giorni assai belli ma con rapida
discesa barometrica che nel dopopranzo del 21 fu accompagnata da
gagliardo vento di S e da nebbie. Ripulì tosto il barometro con
pioggia ai 22, poi bellissimo giornata e barom. alto e normale
fino ai 27 in cui cominciò a scendere nuovo con pioggia ai 29
e forte Sud ai 30.
